

6 years old male child reported to the dental department of Inamdar Multispeciality Hospital with a broken upper right central incisor. As the patient's parents had preserved the broken fragment of the tooth ; a local x ray was taken and it was seen that root formation of the tooth was incomplete.

The treatment alternative that was available was apexogenesis, but since the tooth was asymptomatic it was decided to attempt a conservative approach. A thin layer of MTA base was given over the exposed dentine . Then the tooth fragment was cemented back onto the tooth with an aesthetic filling material, thus restoring aesthetics and function
